Mountain Leader Award Assessment



The Mountain Leader Award is aimed at those people who have a genuine interest in leading groups and who wish to lead a group of hill walkers anywhere in the UK under summer conditions.

The assessment follows on from the training course and assesses the skills required for leading a group in mountainous terrain. Such skills include group management, navigation, - especially in poor weather conditions or reduced visibility, emergency procedures and equipment, access and conservation knowledge, and security on steep ground. There is an expedition element to the syllabus.

Pre-requisites are as follows:

- Logged **at least** 40 quality mountain days
- Have attended a recognised training course or have written proof of exemption from the training course.
- Have completed a post training consolidation period (devised on training course)
- Logged some leadership experience
- Hold First Aid certificate
- 18 years old or over
