

Single Pitch Award Assessment



The Single Pitch Award is aimed at those who wish to supervise a group on single pitch crags and climbing walls and is the key qualification needed by those wanting to pass on their climbing enthusiasm or and wanting to forge a career in “land-based” outdoor activity instruction.

The assessment follows on from the training course and assesses the abilities required for safe group management and effective supervision of climbing activity at indoor and outdoor venues. Skills assessed include: personal climbing ability, rope management, the correct use of equipment, venue choice and emergency procedures.

Pre-requisites are as follows:

- Have completed an SPA training course (or gained successful exemption)
- Satisfied post training consolidation requirements (devised on training course)
- Completed logbook with minimum of 40 routes led outdoors (using leader placed protection)
- Have a current First Aid certificate
- 18 years old or over
- Be a member of a Mountaineering Council
